4.10 •• Issue with water being gone on Old Cove Road for 4 days after hydrant flushing. Brought up three concerns. The first being that the town has outgrown the gravity flow system and that it needs a pump to push water and have higher pressure. The second concern is that the issues going on in this area has been going on for 30+ years and council needs to take action. The third

concern is the towns contingency plan if there is a fire and no water in the pond. Council recognized their concerns and stated that they will be looking at making steps to take action to this problem in.

- 6.2 Recreation Committee Ice Hockey Rental Set Rate Council discussed keeping rates as they are as they are lower than majority of other arena rental rates in the province.
- 6.3 Maintenance Yard Storage for Equipment Council review 3 quotes for SeaCans: OceaneX 2 used at \$5,400/unit plus HST and delivery with Mariner Surveys; Clyde Way Trucking \$7,000/unit and \$700/shipping of each unit plus HST; Ocean SeaCans \$7,200/unit plus HST and free delivery. Council agreed to purchase the 2 SeaCans with free shipping.

6.4 Water Pump Installation at Pond Road – Council discussed possibility of installing a water pump. Mayor Cullihall to reach out to MHA office to request support in rectifying the water pressure issue.

6.5 2024/2025 Fire Protection Financial Assistance Grant – Payment Plan. Council reviewed budget. Council agreed that this equipment is needed for the Fire Department by the end of the year before it expires and will pay the portion of the grant. Equipment includes 8 SCBA, 8 Facepieces, and 16 Cylinders The cost sharing arrangement for the project is a 80/20 Provincial/Municipal rate; \$98,970.19 – Provincial Share and \$24,742.55 – Municipal Share.
